The classic story of “boy meets girl” goes horribly wrong when Ryan, a charming young bank teller becomes instantly obsessed the moment he sees the frosty, career-driven Angelica. Consumed by his curiosity, Ryan begins stalking Angelica, desperate to know more about her. He stumbles upon the perfect opportunity to spy on the woman of his dreams when he is hired by Dolores as a part-time maintenance man and moves into an apartment across the street from Angelica. As the line separating love and lust becomes harder to define, his growing fascination sends him deeper into a bizarre world of obsession and infatuation, but things are not always what they seem in this twisty tale of psychological suspense.

This daring suspense thriller, starring Cyndi Williams (*The Cassidy Kids*, and nominated for Best Lead Actress in the Independent Spirit Awards for her performance in *Room*), David Lago (“7th Heaven” and Emmy Award-winning performance for his portrayal of Raul on “The Young and the Restless”) and LisaMarie Lamendola (“Prison Break,” *The Kings of Appletown*) takes you inside the distorted reality of twisted obsession.

*Deeper and Deeper* is a highly provocative and voyeuristic film, where you can never be sure who is watching or who is pulling the strings.

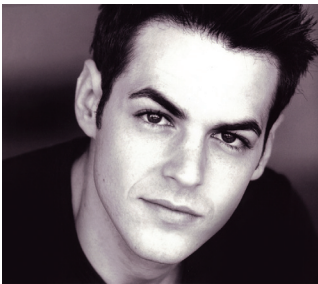

## BIOGRAPHIES FOR DEEPER AND DEEPER



**Cyndi Williams** is an award-winning Austin-based writer, actor, and director. A founding core member of Austin Script Works, her plays include "A Name for a Ghost to Mutter," "American Arcana," "Where Are They Now?" and "Dug Up." In addition to writing *Deeper and Deeper*, Cyndi played one of the lead roles in the production. She starred in the independent film *Room* which garnered her nomination for Best Lead Actress in the Independent Spirit Awards. She received the Karen Morley Award from the American Women Film Critics for her performance. She has made numerous stage appearances, including "The

Assumption" for Refraction Arts Project, for which she serves as Managing Director.



**David Scott Lago** is an Emmy Award-winning actor and celebrates over a decade of achievement in the entertainment industry with five Emmy Nominations. In addition to his Emmy win for his portrayal of Raul on the number one rated CBS soap opera, "The Young and the Restless." Lago is most often recognized by fans for his memorable recurring role of "Jeremy" on the classic, long-running Aaron Spelling-produced television show "7th Heaven."

In addition to his two television roles, the Cuban-American actor has starred in and/or produced several independent feature films for the past five years while being away from the small screen. Most notably among Lago's film roles is the highly-acclaimed thriller, *The Commune*, which was just selected as a Finalist in the prestigious Hollywood filmmaker's competition "Dances With Films" in June 2009.



**LisaMarie Lamendola** is originally from Rochester, New York, and began taking acting classes in Houston, when she auditioned for the television shopping network CDN. Within a year, LisaMarie was hosting over 2,400 Live TV hours. She then decided to move to Los Angeles, where she landed some TV shows, two national commercials and modeling jobs. LisaMarie began hosting for fitness shows, such as the "Torso Tiger," a best-selling infomercial, "Total Tiger," and "Lasting Straight." Then she landed her first lead in the Independent Film, *Echo of Blue*, playing Marine-turned-detective "Archie Lee."

LisaMarie took the advice of her former agent and decided to move back to Austin, Texas. In less than two months, she booked FOX's "Prison Break" and began working in commercials. She landed the role of Mrs. Ramos in *Kings of Appletown*, directed by Bobby Moresco (Academy Award Winner for the screenplay *Crash*.) LisaMarie also shot a guest starring role in the Austin-based television hit series "Friday Night Lights" as "Mrs. Davenport."

## DIRECTOR / PRODUCER

Film director / producer **Mariusz Kotowski**, (pronounced “Ma-roosh Kot-ov-ski”), was born in Olsztyn, Poland on the same date as his idol: legendary Hollywood director Billy Wilder (also a native of the Polish region). Growing up, he was greatly influenced by works of the great Polish directors (Andre Wajda, Krzysztof Kieslowski, and Roman Polanski); yet, he also found the same love in legendary Hollywood movies (such as the larger-than-life classics of Wilder, Alfred Hitchcock, and Orson Welles). With no film training available in the small town of Olsztyn, Mariusz chose to use the region’s greatest artistic resource, dance, as his creative outlet. Choreography and dance would prove to be his ticket to the world.

Mariusz choreographed, performed, and competed in dance throughout Europe. His success as a choreographer eventually landed him in New York where Mariusz would meet and marry his wife. It was also in New York that Mariusz embraced his life-long dream to direct full-length feature films. He trained and choreographed for film and Broadway by day and immersed himself in the study of film direction at New York University by night. After graduating from NYU Film School, Mariusz established Bright Shining City Productions in Austin, TX. Since his move to Austin, Mariusz has completed three films in three years and has several projects in development.

His first film project, *Pola Negri: Life Is a Dream in Cinema*, premiered to two packed screenings at The Museum of Modern Art in New York City and went on to win several independent film awards. This enlightening documentary presents the life and work of legendary Polish actress Pola Negri, once the most famous silent film star in the world. It features commentaries from Academy Award-winner Hayley Mills and veteran actor Eli Wallach.

*Esther’s Diary*, a dramatic feature, explores the internal conflicts that haunt survivors and descendants (both Jewish and Christian) of the Polish holocaust.

*Deeper and Deeper*, meanwhile, is Mariusz’s first feature film exploring the psychological-thriller genre (an area made popular by one of his heroes, Alfred Hitchcock).

## EXECUTIVE PRODUCER

**Heidi Hutter** has served as Executive Producer on all films from Bright Shining City Productions. In 2005, Ms. Hutter and her partners Jose Montemayor and Jay Novik formed Black Diamond Capital Partners, a private equity fund specializing in insurance.

Heidi is a Fellow of the Casualty Actuarial Society, a member of the American Academy of Actuaries and a member of the Board of Overseers of The School of Risk Management at St. John's University. She is a Director of Aspen Insurance Holdings Ltd. (NYSE: AHL), Aquila, Inc. (NYSE: ILA), and Chairman and member of the board of Amerilife Group Holdings.
